William Stuart Nelson Eagles (1871-1947) was the son of Gideon and Mary Ann (nee Davis) Eagles. He married Elsie Jane Davison and had three children. According to the Eagles Families of North America (page 117-119), William left the Gaspereau Valley and went to Portsmouth, NH, for several years. He returned to the Hantsport area and worked as a butcher before going back to Vermont. In 1902, William came back to Kings County and had a farm and saw mill in Gaspereau.

The ledgers to which these indexes correspond are not included in the accession and their location is unknown

William S. Eagles is listed as a property owner in Hantsport in the 1896 McAlpine's Directory

1900.476-EAG/1 index [18--] of names with corresponding page number. Many of the names are from the Kings County area, but some entries are for Digby and Lunenburg Counties. Handwriting may be the same as file number 2

1900.476-EAG/2 index (1893) of names with corresponding page number. Many of the names are from the Horton area. Written on the inside cover: "William S. Eagles / Hantsport / 1893". Handwriting may be the same as file number 1

1900.476-EAG/3 index [18--] of names with corresponding page number. Many of the names are from the Horton area

1900.476-EAG/4 index (1887) of names with corresponding page number. Many of the names are from the Eastern Kings County area. Written on front page: "August the 9 1887 / Mary [?]"

1900.476-EAG/5A index [18--], (1885, 1894) of names with corresponding page number. Many of the names are from the Eastern Kings County area. Included as 1900.476-EAG/5B are four pages that were inserted in this index. Items are: a letter to George Hamilton in Grand Pre from C.H. Reid, a list of names with corresponding amounts of money, a list of notes including names with corresponding amounts of money, and a leaflet by the King's County Agricultural Society entitled "Scheme of encouragement for 1824"

1900.476-EAG/6 ledger (1893-1894, 1903-1929) includes many names from the Horton, Gaspereau, and Wolfville areas
