Accession consists of material created and-GRA/or accumulated by Alice (Chipman) Graham. The material largely concerns the settlement and disposition of the estate of her father, Ross Chipman. Documents relate to Ross's land holdings such as deeds, leases, property plans, estate inventories, invoices and accounts, and correspondence concerning property surveys, appraisals, and the disposition of assets. Also includes a few personal letters written by Alice Chipman in 1906 to her family, while she was visiting New York City.
