Biographical Information

Stephen March was born in England on 28 March 1832. As a young man March studied law in London. In 1851 he professed the Baptist religion. He emigrated to New Brunswick in 1854 where he was employed by the *Christian Visitor* for a short time. Rev. March was ordained July 1856, at St. Francis Baptist Church in St. Francis, New Brunswick. By 1859 he had moved to St. George, NB and was pastor of the St. George Baptist Church; however, in 1860 he became pastor of the Bridgewater Baptist Church, Bridgewater, Nova Scotia where he remained for twelve years. In 1872 Rev. March accepted a call to Onslow, NS where he stayed for three years until he removed to Canning, NS. He returned after two years to Bridgewater, where he continued as pastor for sixteen years. Next he went for a year to West Baptist Church, Halifax, NS for one year and then spent two years at North Kingston, NS. Finally he again returned to Bridgewater. Reverend Stephen March died on 1 May 1907.

Custodial History

This fonds was donated in 1986 by R. H. March of the Department of Physics, Dalhousie University. The relationship of the donor to Stephen March has not been determined.

Scope and Content

Fonds consists of two series. Series one contains correspondence to and from Rev. Stephen March, and series two contains speeches, sermons, essays, hymns and poems that he wrote.
