### Administrative History

Hazen Coles Parent was born in Saint John, N.B. in 1926 and died in Bridgewater, N.S. in 2005. Parent went to study at Gordon College, Boston MA, in 1945; he also studied at the Acadia Divinity College, obtaining a Bach. of Divinity in 1961. Hazen Parent was a Baptist minister, living in Massachusetts, New Brunswick, Nova Scotia, and Ontario. He was also a missionary in Bolivia. Being a Baptist historian, Parent served as the Chair of the Baptist Historical Committee.

He married Hazel Mildred Anderson in 1947 and they had three children: Gregory, Mark, and Carole. Hazel Mildred Anderson Parent (b.1926) graduated from Acadia University in 1979 with a Bachelor of Theology degree. She accompanied her husband while he was a missionary in Bolivia. Hazel is a retired Chaplain with Canadian Correctional Services.
