Scope and Content

The fonds consists of one duo-tang folder of information compiled by William Parquet about the Seminary Building, Acadia University, Wolfville, Nova Scotia.

Seminary House Project, William Parquet, 1989. – [1989]. - 1 v of textual records. – 33 photographs : b&w and col. ; 20 x 25 cm or smaller

File contains a duo-tang folder of information that was completed for a class project. Parquet assembled information from available sources about the Seminary building, student-life, ghost folklore, etc. Includes a number of photographs, floor plans, photocopies of newspaper clippings, quotations from published sources and from interviews, and a provincial site inventory form for the building. The photographs are mostly copyprints of old images, but Parquet also included modern photographs of himself and his friends in the building.

The Seminary Building was built in 1879 to house the classrooms and residence rooms of young ladies attending the Acadia Ladies' Seminary. Starting in the summer of 1890, it was used by local company F. P. Rockwell Co. as the Acadia Seminary Hotel. When the Ladies' Seminary closed in 1927, the building was used as a residence for university students.
